Robin Fraser: Salt and pepper shaker
with no holes in top, The salt comes
out the bottom when shaken. He had
one cut in half to show the internal
mechanism to accomplish this. Also
brought square wood with round ball
embedded. Showed jig to turn it.



CrisDeCammills: Large thin spalted maple bowls, Small crab apple bowl.

Dave Watt: Small bowl from burl from Beaver Island.

Mark Andrus: Thin platter



Fitch Hasbrouck: Casting experiment with leaves.



Dave Kukla: Sweet Cherry natural edge bowl.





Started with 3X3X9 maple block between centers. Round and turn tenon for chuck on one end. John does this with a bedan tool. It is like a wide parting tool. He made the hat first. parting tool to make brim he turned the three body balls with a bowl gouge. Finish cut with a shear scrape. Sand 150 and part off.

John Sheets Snowman and Christmas tree

Christmas tree starts the same way as Snowman. Turn to taper of tree. Lay out each layer of branches with thin parting tool. Concave each section of branches with bowl gouge. Undercut each branch section. Sand.
